Next weekend, 15-16 June, we have one of the most important weekends in the yearly life of our parish. On the Saturday Bishop Richard will be coming to give the Sacrament of Confirmation to our young people, and on the Sunday we will be having our parish First Holy Communions. These are profoundly important moments for our young people, our next generation of Christians. Beginning with Baptism these two sacraments complete what we call the Sacraments of Initiation. They prepare us and equip us for our life as disciples of Jesus Christ. We cannot live as Christians by our own strength. The words of the Lord tell us this, 'Without me you can do nothing'. But we are not alone, we have the sacraments, the means through which God comes to us, makes us children of God, pours grace into our hearts, transforms us and makes each of us what we are meant to be – other Christs. St Francis de Sales once wrote, 'Be who you are, and be that well, that you may give honour to the Divine Artisan whose handiwork you are.' Through our fidelity to daily prayer, regular confession and Sunday Mass may the Good Lord accomplish this in our young people and in each one of us. God bless and keep you, Fr Bruno.

CARLO ACUTIS: THE FIRST 'MILLENNIAL SAINT': The Londonborn Italian teenager Carlo Acutis aged only 15 was diagnosed with untreatable leukaemia and died in 2006. He is likely to become the first "millennial saint" after two miracles have been attributed to him; (i) the healing of a Brazilian child's pancreas and (ii) the healing of a Costa Rican woman from severe head and brain surgery despite her chance of survival being incredibly low. Pope Francis describes him as "understanding the needs of his time" while still believing that "true happiness is found by putting God in first place". Having a young, digitally "switched on" saint brings a new emphasis to Catholic teaching on young people's engagement with the internet and digital world Carlo also loved playing video games and teaching himself computer coding and animation.
