he more we learn about the crowds who followed Jesus wherever he went, and the lengths he had to go to if he wanted time to himself, going up mountains and crossing lakes in boats, the more we are inclined to speculate about what the crowds were thinking. Jesus asks the question for us. "Who do the crowds say I am"? The answers are many, varied—and all off the mark. They know Jesus is a holy man, they think probably a prophet, but in truth they don't come close to an answer. It is Peter who speaks up and his answer reveals just how much he understands. It is tempting to think his answer also shows how the finger of God has singled him out, has given him the depth of understanding that others lack, for it is Peter who says, with complete certainty, 'The Christ of God'. But why does Jesus want this kept secret? Only his small bank of special disciples are in the know. Is it because he wants the people to work it out for themselves, is it because he knows that they would not believe what the disciples would be telling them? Or perhaps it is because until the glories of the resurrection are revealed, the prophesies will not have been fulfilled. Christ needs to live out his destiny as he describes it to the disciples. He must suffer, he must die and he must rise again in order to give us salvation. What he is prepared to say to all, and to us, is that we must put our faith in God and in his

Son ahead of everything.
