Last Wednesday we began the great season of Lent. One of the features of these 40 days is that each day has its own prayers and readings for Mass. These guide us 'that we may grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ' [Collect for the First Sunday in Lent]. The First Sunday of Lent is always the Sunday in which we hear of the temptations of Our Lord in the desert. The Church has seen this as Jesus showing us that as he was tempted before beginning his public ministry so we should not be surprised if in turn we too are tempted and obstacles come our way whenever we set out to do God's will and follow Jesus. The devil leaves us alone if he sees we are not on the way to heaven as he has us, but as soon as we set out on the path of following Our Lord Jesus, he will do all he can to distract and stop us. The way Our Lord deals with the temptations teaches us how to deal with them too: the Word of God is that by which we live, not our own ideas and desires; trust and faith in God is our path; and we bow down not to the world but to God alone. Have courage and may God bless us all this Lent, Fr Bruno.
