

# FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

T oday we begin Advent, our time of waiting for the 'coming' of the Lord. The readings for the coming weeks remind us that this happens on more than one level. Christ, they say, has come to us in <u>history</u>, in that birth at Bethlehem, the very first Christmas. Then, in every generation since, Christ has come to each person in <u>mystery</u>: in the sacraments, and in the 'sacrament of the present moment.'

But a key part of our faith, and one we may lose sight of, is his coming in <u>glory</u>. Like a film camera which starts off showing the wide lens overview of the whole picture, the scripture for the first Sunday of Advent focusses on God's plan for the destiny of the whole world. The prophets had spoken of a 'Day of the Lord' at the end of time. It would be, above all, an act of God, rather than just a human project. But we could play our part by "turning towards" (which is the origin of the word 'repent') this reality that is coming. So this Day, which often arouses fear, would become something to look forward to with joy and hope.

This give us a whole attitude of prayer and discipline. St Francis used to pray, "Lord, give me a spirit of joyful penance and keep me single-minded in your service".
