Detachment not Attachment

Today's readings present a notable contrast. The readings appear to be tough on wealth and material possessions. In the first reading, Amos the Prophet of social Justice warns those who take consolation in material possessions that all that we own does not persist after our earthly life. But rather, we should store up treasures for ourselves in heaven by putting at the service of humanity the riches and wealth God has given to us. The gospel reading on the other hand, condemned the rich man for ignoring the needs of Lazarus, the poor man sitting at his gate. The rich man feasted lavishly while neglecting the basic needs of Lazarus. The rich man was so attached to his wealth that he was blinded by it. The name of the rich man was not given in the gospel, meaning that it could be any of us who may be too attached to anything that we own. St. Paul, in the second reading, calls us to see righteousness, to share our resources with those in need so that we can be free from any reproach. God bless, Fr. Charles
