THE PARISH OF OUR LADY OF RANSOM St GREGORY AND St AGNES

Cardinal Vincent Nichols, who is President of the Prison Advice and Care Trust (Pact), has asked us to join him in supporting this Prisoners Sunday.

This is a special year for Pact as it reaches its 120th year of supporting prisoners and people with convictions, as well as their children and families. It was founded in 1898 by Canon Cooney who provided care for Catholic prisoners and their families in London. Today it supports prisoners from every diocese in England and Wales, working with them from the point of sentencing to release.

This year, over 200,00 children will suffer the heartache and trauma of the arrest, trial and imprisonment of a parent. Pact supports prisoners' children as they seek to maintain meaningful relationships with their parents in prison.

Cardinal Nichols says that this may not be the easiest of causes to support but we do well to remember that visiting the imprisoned is one of the Corporal Works of Mercy (cf Matt 25:35). We might reflect too how Jesus himself experienced imprisonment and judgement at the end of his life on Earth.

There is no retiring collection but envelopes are available at the back of the Church, should you wish to use one.

May we particularly remember the work Fr Raglan and Fr Tristan do in Lewes Prison and thank them for it.
