# WHEN I WAS IN PRISON YOU VISITED ME - (MT 25: 36)

This Sunday concludes the end of a special week of prayer for prisoners and their families. I celebrate Mass every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday at HMP Lewes and will often mention something from the visit in my parish Sunday sermon. This is because I always feel touched by the experience of ministering in prison and remembering the words of Jesus from Matthew 25 quoted above. Before I felt called to the priesthood, I studied a Law degree and spent quite a lot of work experience time sitting in criminal trials. Often I was struck by the plight of those "in the dock", all those powerful mitigating circumstances of their often difficult and very broken lives. But by the grace of God go I, go any of us! We are a parish that wants to commit to being ever more welcoming, especially to those who might easily be stigmatised and pushed to the edges ... ex-prisoners being a powerful example. We are registering as a parish to be part of The Welcome Directory (<a href="www.welcomedirectory.org.uk">www.welcomedirectory.org.uk</a>) an organisation that helps faith communities become places where people leaving prison can find acceptance. #### **PASTORAL & FAITH DEVELOPMENT**

**ROSARY FOR PEACE:** is prayed every Thursday, *during Exposition* at OLR between 10.20 – 10.50am. Please join in.

THE CHALLENGE OF CLIMATE CHANGE: Pope Francis has issued a new document Laudate Deum a sequel to his Laudato Si eight years ago. The Pope makes clear that the motivation for his letter arises from the insufficient action across the world in these intervening years, and its impact, especially on the most vulnerable. The Holy Father speaks of climate change as a global reality, and the responsibility that we all have for this change. The Holy Father examines in detail the many causes of this phenomenon, including the demands on natural resources that arise in an increasingly technocratic age - something that it is easy to overlook – and he relates this to the desire for power that is so often a part of our human desire, seeking to place ourselves in God's place. He speaks of the current situation in international politics and outlines the journey made by the COP conferences, noting the difficulties to come to agreements, noting their poor implementation. We may feel overwhelmed by the task ahead but the Holy Father addresses this also, pointing out that little things can make a difference and calling us to cultural change, especially for those of us living in richer nations.

PARISH SMALL CHARITIES PROJECT: we have been blessed with many generous legacies and as part of our mission of outreach to those in need we will make available £15K of parish funds to be made available in 30 X £500 donations to small scale charitable projects proposed by parishioners. THESE SHOULD BE: small scale registered charities local or further afield, consistent with our Catholic values (though don't have to be religious based charities), not already being supported through parish collections or fundraising. Please send your proposals to the Parish Office in writing, with a small explanation of the charity, by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October.

KNIGHTS OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE: On Saturday 21st October we welcome the Southern Section of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem (EOHSJ) to celebrate Mass with us in OLR at 10.30am (please note Mass time changed from usual 10am). The Order supports in many ways the "Living Stones" of the Holy Land, the people who maintain and keep the Catholic Faith alive, often under very difficult and dangerous conditions and without adequate resources. The Order also sponsors students for the priesthood, parishes and schools and numerous catholic charities as well as helping to maintain the holy sites for future generations. All are welcome to this celebration.
