Today's Gospel reading presents the parable of two men who went into the temple to pray. One was a Pharisee who considered himself a "saint". And the other was a tax collector, who considered himself a "sinner". The fact that they were both in the temple to pray at the same time underlines the fact that the church, which is the temple of God, welcomes all, both saints and sinners. In the church, saints are strengthened and encouraged while sinners are purified and redeemed. What this demonstrates to us today is that no one should feel left out in the church - all are welcome. No one should feel too sinful not to come to the presence of God. In God's presence, we ought not to look down on anyone but pray for the grace to always do God's will. The book of Sirach tells us that God will judge without partiality. He will give everyone a chance to work out their salvation. Saint Paul, in the second reading, hopes that we will seize this opportunity that God has given us today to do his will so that on the last day we will be crowned with righteousness. Come to Jesus now, because you are welcome! *Fr Charles*

VATICAN MESSAGE INVITES HINDUS AND CHRISTIANS TO NURTURE PEACE IN OUR HOMES AND COMMUNITIES: On 28 October 2025, we mark the 60th Anniversary of Nostra Aetate, 'In Our Time', the declaration of the Second Vatican Council that encouraged Catholics around the world to engage in dialogue and collaboration with people of other religious traditions. It is still considered a foundational text for this important dialogue. The Hindu feast of Deepavali (Diwali) fell on 20 October this year – eight days before Nostra Aetate's diamond jubilee.
