This week we begin November. After the holy day of All Saints on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month, the next day, All Souls, Masses throughout the world are offered for the faithful departed. The offering of Mass, which makes present the sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary and extends the graces of that moment to the present, has always been the principal means by which the Church fulfils the commandment of charity towards the dead. The Church also asks us to pray for all the faithful departed throughout November. In some countries cemeteries are full of votive candles this month. Something we can do at home is to write out a list of our loved ones who have died and every day this month say a prayer for them, for example a decade of the Rosary. Also, an even better thing is to come to Mass on extra occasions and come with the specific intention of offering to God those persons during the Mass and receiving Holy Communion for them. Even after death, links with our loved ones are not broken and we can do good for them. St Padre Pio said 'We must empty purgatory with our prayers'. God bless you this November, Fr Bruno
