# **DRIVING OUT THE MONEY CHANGERS!**

The Gospel this 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent is one of those rare moments where Jesus *appears* to succumb to what we fallible human beings often fall into ... "a fit of anger" ... or even worse an outright "rage"! Jesus was perfectly human (and perfectly Divine) so there's no reason why Jesus didn't, and he clearly did, experience the human tensions and emotions we experience ... sadness, fear and even anger. Unlike us, however, Jesus would quickly have channelled these emotions into his Divine Mission – here in the Jerusalem Temple he gives is both a legitimate PROTEST SIGN (= the money changers and animal sellers have corrupted the Temple and turned it into a den of capitalist avarice and greed at the expense of the poor) plus a PROPHETIC SIGN (= all Temple worship will give way to a new definitive worship where his Crucified and Risen Body will be the new and permanent Temple where God is worshipped in Spirit and in Truth). As we continue our journey towards Holy Week and Easter may we all be aware of the danger of mis-channelled anger but also of how easily we can become complacent in allowing what is "of God" to be corrupted by human values. What is most importantly "of God" are human beings, made in God's image and likeness, whose dignity must be defended and upheld with utmost care. God bless – Fr Kevin
