BE BOLD IN FAITH AND LOVE!

Over these weeks of Easter we are listening to the Acts of the Apostles every day describing "our roots", "our beginnings", as Church. We are the distant (many-generations-on) family of the Apostles and first Christians. We have received from them our "family story", the beliefs and traditions and customs that identify who we are as believers in Jesus the Risen Lord. They are always with us, "alive in the Lord" just as we are alive in the Lord! There is no separation. Today we read of Saul who becomes Paul, arch-persecutor who is slain and reborn by Christ's love on the road to Damascus and becomes arch-defender of the Church. He loved Christ and the Church with a love stronger than death, a response to the very love of Christ Himself for us. Paul gave his all with utmost joy. As we look ahead and to the big challenges that we will face in these coming months, as we prepare to become a single Parish from here to Rye, let us pray for that Spirit filled confidence and love that marked the life of the early Church – "for He is the Vine and we are the Branches!
