# **BEGINNINGS IN PRAYER**

Last Thursday, 9 May, we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord 40 days after his Resurrection. Next Sunday, 19 May we will celebrate the feast of Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the birth of the Church. In those days between the Ascension and Pentecost the Apostles were not idle, but rather gathered in prayer with Mary, the mother of the Lord. It shows us again how prayer is always that necessary preparation for God to act in us and through us. Jesus began his public ministry with 40 days of prayer and fasting in the desert and rejecting the wiles of the devil. Often in the gospels we hear how in the morning the Lord was not around and they would find him praying. Before choosing the 12 Apostles Jesus spent the night in prayer, and his passion began with prayer in the garden of Gethsemane. Today the Church prays the Divine Office, 7 times of prayer throughout the day and night. We too, as followers of Jesus must pray every day. We want God to act in us and through us too. From prayer we learn that we are not alone, but we pray to always do the Father's will, to live in communion with Jesus and to beg for the Holy Spirit to transform us as he transformed the first Apostles at Pentecost. And always we remember Mary is with us. Once again, Come Holy Spirit, our need is great. God bless you, Fr Bruno

ROME CALL FOR AI ETHICS: - In his message for the 58th World Day of Communications, this coming Sunday, 12 May, Pope Francis has expressed his concern about the increasing influence of artificial intelligence (AI) in society. He adds: "AI is radically affecting the world of information and communication, and through it, certain foundations of life in society," adding that "these changes affect everyone." In the light of this apparently fundamental shift in human interactions, the Pope asks: "how can we remain fully human and guide this cultural transformation to serve a good purpose?". Al, he says, presents both an opportunity and a threat. "Human beings alone" are capable of making sense of information and in the wrong hands AI becomes "perverse when it distorts our relationship with others and with reality" and even has the potential to create "disturbing scenarios." Others go much further warning that AI has a perfectly feasible ability to wreak havoc with humanity, and even bring about its annihilation.
