t Easter Archbishop Peter Smith asked me to release Fr. David for transfer to the parish of Bognor, after four years in Eastbourne. I was relieved, however, that he will have a replacement: Fr. Gerard Hatton from Crawley parish, whom I have known with respect and affection for some years.

We have been fortunate to have had David's ministry for that length of time. From the start, I was aware of a priest whose absolute focus was, clearly, the person Jesus Christ. That meant a vision in which all of us are on a journey of discipleship. But what these years have provided has been the space and time for David's creativity to flourish. He has found ways to show that Catholic faith, inspired by the Word of God, can really 'become flesh' in our society in this 21st century. It's a journey where the Lord certainly doesn't promise an easy path all the time; but one full of meaning.

Well, it is also a blessing that we have a little time to plan a fuller way to give thanks for David's ministry here. Very appropriately he will stay in Eastbourne long enough for the 'other' Jubilee this year: the 50th anniversary Mass with our new Bishop Richard, of St. Gregory's Church on September 6th. Meanwhile please remember David in your prayers, and Gerard and all our younger priests who are carrying a weight of expectation and responsibility for the Church in this part of the world.
