THE PARISH OF OUR LADY OF RANSOM St GREGORY AND St AGNES

The reading this weekend is one of the most dramatic and explanatory passages of St John's Gospel.

We can picture the two men standing looking at each other but there is a feeling that this is not a confrontational meeting. Pilate, probably dressed in purple, is the visible face of the might of Rome, no doubt with a few armed bodyguards behind him. Jesus is dignified, almost serene, dressed simply in the robe over which, a few hours later, the centurians would be casting lots.

Pilate makes plain his position when he says "Am I a Jew?" He is giving the impression that this is a little local difficulty on which he has to adjudicate. But he also gives the impression that he is intrigued by Jesus. He must have had questions in his mind. Why were the Jews in such a hurry to bring Jesus to his court? Why did they want him dealt with so quickly? After all, it is nearly the Sabbath. Why can't this business wait a day or two?

We can also imagine the Jewish hierarchy waiting for the verdict, and surely there were some who were inciting the crowd to shout for Barabbas.

It is a big open stage, charged with tension and it is the moment when Jesus, calmly and clearly states exactly who he is. "Yes, I am a king. I was born for this, I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth: and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice".

Today we listen again to that voice, and give thanks for Christ, our King.
