EASTER – THE TRIUMPH OF LOVE

The Easter events heighten the contrast between the ways of the world and God's ways. The worldly powers that conspired to put Jesus to death ensured that this event would be in a torrent of violence, as if to declare loudly that they were in control. In contrast the Resurrection of Jesus is marked by profound simplicity and gentleness that can be readily dismissed as insignificant or misinterpreted - an empty tomb and discarded burial cloths. Even Mary Magdalene initially misread this as theft by Jesus' enemies. But one disciple, identified as the beloved of Jesus, looks through the eyes of the heart, understands the signs, and believes. The only way to see and believe is through the eyes of love. Jesus' death is the greatest act of love, His Resurrection is the greatest victory of love. Love is God's way, love has the final word, love is victorious!

SOME PROMPTS FOR PRAYER IN EASTERTIDE

THE CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY: is a Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy, based on the Christological apparitions of Jesus reported by St Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938), known as "the Apostle of Mercy". She was canonized as a saint in the year 2000. Celebration of the Feast of the Divine Mercy takes place on 7 April 2024. Divine Mercy Devotions will be led at 3pm in Our Lady of Ransom by Fr Kevin.

"AT PRAYER WITH THOMAS MERTON": presents on YouTube 'daily prayers for dawn and dusk', drawn from the writings of the great 20th century Trappist mystic, Thomas Merton, interwoven with excerpts set to music composed by the sacred music composer Kathleen Deignan. This is a beautiful resource for a contemplative start and finish to each day of the week.
