There is absolutely no ambiguity about today's Gospel. Jesus states clearly and precisely "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me". He then sends out the disciples to convert all the nations of the world, having assured them of his authority.

Their mission is to baptise and this is where the Trinity is stated so clearly. They are to baptise in the "name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". Of great important is the use of the word 'name'. It is singular, not plural. He is not referring to three separate entities, he is specifically using the terminology which refers to the God who is One, yet who is also Three in One.

Understanding the Trinity has been something for lay people and theologians alike to wrestle with through the centuries but probably it is best just to accept it for the miracle it is, our God, three persons, one nature, who meets every human need, who understands every human failing, who appreciates the good that it is possible for human beings to do and the errors which can occur to trip us up.

Sometimes we can become too tortured by the need to 'understand' when loving acceptance would be a much better option. And so, when we make the Sign of the Cross, we pay homage to our beloved Trinity.
