THE HOLY TRINITY

How do we begin to understand the Mystery of the Holy Trinity? One of the key words the Church uses when talking about the mystery of God is the word **GIFT** – we receive God as Gift, and all things associated with God are received and experienced as Gift. God is pure Love, as we've been hearing through the Gospel and Letters of St John over the final days of Eastertide. True Love (and God is the Truest form of Love) will always be **FREE GIFT**. So, we receive the mystery of the Trinity as a revelation through the Scriptures and above all through the life, teaching, death, and Resurrection of Jesus. All is gift and all is an expression of pure love.

That's why the Holy Trinity (*3 persons in 1 Godhead*) makes perfect sense: **LOVE MUST BE A COMMUNITY!** How can we experience love in isolation, how can our experience of God not be an experience of community? We all have the imprint of God in our soul, and that is an imprint of belonging to community, to God and to each other, as God's beloved family.

Loneliness and isolation are terrible scourges and suffering for many people. A great part of the mission of the Church – in proclaiming the Gospel - is to proclaim that everyone belongs together in God, without exception – as we hear in St John's Gospel *"Jesus died to gather together the scattered children of God" (Jn: 11;52)*

THE FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY: Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity and Pope Francis issues a sobering spiritual challenge for the week ahead, one that touches the essence of Mission. He encourages us to look at ourselves, stressing that our words must translate into actions. This is why, the Pope says, "celebrating the Holy Trinity is not so much a theological exercise, but a revolution in our way of life. God, in whom each Person lives for the other, not for himself, provokes us to live with others and for others". We must also ask ourselves if our life reflects the God we believe in: do I, who profess faith in God the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, truly believe that in order to live I need others, I need to give myself to others, I need to serve others? Do I affirm this in words or with my life?" In other words, in everyday life, am I too a reflection of the Trinity?" Does the Sign of the Cross that I make every day, remain just a gesture for its own sake, or does it inspire my way of speaking, of encountering, of responding, of judging, of forgiving?" Reflecting on these words in prayer might really help us as we discern our own role and attitude on the road to our Moderated Parish.
