LOOKING BACK - LOOKING FORWARD

Another busy parish year draws to a close. Much good work has been done in the parish and we have a steady inflow of new parishioners which is a joy and blessing. We've also had a very large number of deaths and bereavements, causes of both deep sadness but also pointing us all to the greatest hope of our faith: the Resurrection and the promise of Eternal Life, Alleluia! Covid and the many restrictions we had to live with now seem a distant memory. There was a lot of talk about how we must move FORWARD and not just REVERT BACK to old (pre-covid) ways! I'm not sure specifically what that has amounted to in practice, but I do feel there's more of a willingness to look at things differently and be bolder and more creative in how we do the things that most matter – in our personal lives and in our parish life. Certainly, in the Diocese, with an ever-smaller number of active priests, we need to be bold and creative in how we use our resources. Our own Parish Mission Prayer (in the box below) gives us a simple but clear focus: to be outward looking, to share the beauty of our faith, draw others to Christ and the Sacraments, especially the Mass, and to be generous in care of the poor and the environment.

Thank you, from Fr Bruno and myself, to each and every one of you for your dedication and hard work in the BIG TEAM EFFORT that is parish life! Thank you also for your great kindness and generosity shown to me recently as I celebrated my 30th anniversary as a priest.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMMES

At the heart of parish life is preparing people – young and older – to receive the Sacraments: Adults coming into the Church (RCIA); First Reconciliation and Communion; Confirmation; Marriage; Baptism. Thanks to our wonderful catechists who already help and to those who, please God, will begin assisting in the new programmes below.

<u>The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Is it for YOU?</u> We're all on a "journey of faith" which is unique and personal, and which is greatly enriched when we come together and share with others. Maybe you're a non-Catholic Christian accompanying your family to the Catholic Church, and now feel drawn to become part of this community of faith. Maybe your "roots" are in another religion, or in none. Maybe you're a Baptised Catholic but never received, as a young person, the Sacrament of Confirmation. In November we begin a new programme. If you are interested, please complete and return the form in the Porch by Friday 13th October or speak to one of the Priests to find out more.

<u>First Holy Communion</u>: Enrolment Forms for First Holy Communion Programme 2023-24 (those entering Year 3 or above) are available in the Porch. The course will begin with an Introductory Meeting on Saturday 23rd September. Deadline for enrolment is Monday 18th September.

<u>Lumen Christi</u> group offers formation for those young Catholics in school years 9-13, with consideration given to seeking the Sacrament of Confirmation (subject to discernment). Registration forms are available in the Porch.
