This Sunday, 11 June, we celebrate Corpus Christi. It is a major feast in the Church celebrated shortly after Pentecost highlighting the astonishing gift of the Mass given to the Church by our Divine Lord. The Eucharist is the greatest treasure we have in the Church. St Thomas Aquinas wrote that the Redeeming Sacrifice of the Cross and Real Presence of the Lord in the Mass is the greatest of all the miracles Jesus worked. Saint Charles de Foucauld, who grew in his love for the Eucharistic through his life wrote, 'One single Mass glorifies God more that the praise of all the angels and the martyrdom of all men could; the martyrdom of all men and the adoration of all the angels are something finite. A Mass is infinite.' He is not exaggerating. Mass is infinite, since at Mass, Jesus, who is God, is the principal priest. An ordinary priest is only an instrument for Jesus. Each Mass brings the infinite into the finite, the eternal into time, God to humanity, salvation to sinners. As we each battle to live our Christian vocation may we never forget the gift of the Mass, the presence of the Eucharistic Lord with us there, and Him whom we receive entire in the Sacred Host. ### **Rosary For Peace**

Prayed every Thursday, *during Exposition* at OLR between 10-10.50am. Please join in.

Some thoughts on the Feast of Corpus Christi: In the Gospel account of Jesus feeding the 5000, He and the disciples are confronted by a large crowd and a large hunger. How can they deal with such a task? Jesus as ever gives them a challenge (as he does to us too) - Give them something to eat yourselves! They have little, so few resources, but Jesus takes their littleness, he blesses it, and he breaks it until it becomes even littler; then he gives this blessed littleness back to them and tells them to give it away. In our own lives we can be overwhelmed by our own lack of resources that appear so inadequate and little, all we have is our own bits and pieces, but that is enough for Jesus to make all things good. Our ministry is to believe that God is there in the midst of our littleness. He challenges us to become his body, to become bread for all who hunger for the presence of God. In the miracle of the feeding of the 5000 he shows us how it works: If you want bread, give bread; If you want love, be loving with others; If you want attention, be attentive to others; If you want affirmation, be affirming of others. Jesus' way is simple: " Give what you hunger for, and you will get back more than enough". That is Gospel". (Inspired by Denis McBride C.Ss.R.)

The Surprise of Prayer: In the wake of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at this time of Pentecost, Pope Francis has some advice for us all; it is this: "Allow yourselves to be surprised by God. Don't be frightened of surprises. They shake the ground from under your feet and they make us unsure. But they move us forward in the right direction." Our beautiful Open Church banner outside Our Lady of Ransom Church also calls us all to "Be surprised by prayer".
