Jesus Christ our Universal King

The Solemnity of Jesus Christ the Universal King on 20th November brings the Church year to a close. We then begin the Season of Advent and a new year (Year A -St Matthew's Gospel). Christ the King is both the final word of the Church Year, but also the word that focuses us on the finality of this world, on the Second Coming of Christ in glory to judge the living and the dead. The return of the Lord will fulfil all God's saving promises in and through the One who was born for us, died for us, and rose for us. The Parable of the Last Judgement ("when I was hungry did you feed me ...") is a powerful reminder that to be a Christian is to be a loving servant to those in most need. Christ the King is also Youth Sunday, and in August hundreds of thousands of young people will be gathering in Lisbon with Pope Francis for the World Youth Day. Praying for our young people is at the heart of the Church's life and mission. Sometimes people say they are "the future", but we want them to know they are the PRESENT and their presence is a source of blessing and joy to us all.
