### **PRAYING FOR PRISONERS**

I want to share with you a few personal words as we mark Prisoner Sunday (16<sup>th</sup> October). My brother is a full-time prison chaplain for the past 6 years, and I have always really admired him for this ministry. We've shared a lot about it over the years. When I was teaching for 4 years in the Seminary, prior to Eastbourne, my own personal pastoral ministry, that took me out of the seminary, was regularly celebrating prison Masses in men's and women's prisons. Arriving in Eastbourne I was happy to know this ministry could continue at HMP Lewes. Most people in prison are themselves victims of many wounds and hurts. As the saying goes "but by the grace of God go of any of us"! As we pray for our brothers and sisters in prison, we pray for their holistic wellbeing, rehabilitation, conversion and for their families, also "victims of crime". We pray for the healing of the wounds of crime and for those entrusted with caring for prisoners. We always remember the words of Jesus in Matthew 25 "What you did to the least of these my brothers and sisters you did to me" —
