The call to work in the harvest:

We hear a lot these days about the difficulties of farmers reaping their harvests in these difficult times. Harvest was an image used by Jesus too for calling his followers to work in the harvest of the kingdom of God. Jesus calls each of us, just as he called the twelve, to continue his loving ministry in our needy world today. At Baptism, we receive the water of God's love and the oil of service, completed in Confirmation, Marriage and Ordination. In a world of brokenness and struggle, Jesus sees people 'like sheep without a shepherd'. He calls us all to play our part, for: "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest". We pray always for new vocations to the Priesthood, but as we continue praying our new Parish Mission Prayer let us all ask for that generosity to be active in the harvest of our community, becoming true disciples who bring the good news

An Invitation from CAFOD: Bishop Richard has already signed.

You are invited to sign a giant letter in the coming days, from

a small-scale farmer called Salina, who lives in Bangladesh. CAFOD, the Catholic Agency for Overseas Development, works with small farmers around the world who produce lots of the world's food. But many of them are facing a huge problem. For hundreds of years, they have freely used and shared their own seeds, but laws are being passed that limit what they are allowed to do with their own seeds, giving them little choice but to buy more expensive seeds from large companies. These laws make it even harder for small farmers and their families to produce enough food. This is why Salina is writing a letter to the World Bank, which has a lot of influence over agricultural issues, asking them to protect the rights of small farmers to use and share their own seeds. Please sign your name, once the forms are available, under Salina's name to add your support (your first name or full name is fine - this is not a petition, it's a show of support).
