#### PRAISE THE LORD, WHO HEALS THE BROKEN HEARTED

With all the pressures, wars, financial and political uncertainty, along with imminent changes in Church and Parish, it is easy to fall into a downward spiral of anxiety. We might resonate with Job in the 1<sup>st</sup> reading: "lying in bed I wonder when it will be day? Rising I think how slowly the evening comes! Restless I fret till twilight falls". Not words to lift flagging spirits, but we know that things come good for Job in the end. But how do we bridge from the struggling spirit of Job to the confidence of St Paul in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading? The response to the psalm points us in the right direction: "Praise the Lord who heals the broken hearted". Jesus IS himself the bridge, the healer of broken hearts, the answer to the deepest hunger and fears of the human heart. As Baptised Christians we are commissioned to preach, in word and action, the Good News of God's love and healing power made visible in Christ. Especially we do this by, like and with Jesus, reaching out to the sick, the poor, the lost, the broken. I would like to thank God this weekend for Fr Stephen Ortiger OSB, former Abbot of Worth who died peacefully during the week, who has always been a great witness to the love and compassion of Christ. May he rest in peace and rise in glory along with all our beloved dead. God bless – Fr Kevin
