PARISH DIARY - APRIL/MAY

5 APRIL: CHRISM MASS AT ARUNDEL CATHEDRAL, 6.00 pm. As well as the Blessing of the Holy Oils, the Diocesan priests and deacons renew their commitment to the Bishop, along with the lay faithful who are present, in a very moving service – get there early if going by car!

<u>9 APRIL</u>: Ecumenical Sunrise Service on Easter Day at 6.10am at Beachy Head war memorial

19 APRIL: Co-Workers of St Mother Teresa meeting after Mass

<u>23 APRIL</u>: Come and celebrate St George's day with a tea party after Mass. (sweet treats).

25 APRIL: **MONTHLY EASTBOURNE HOSPITAL MASS**: 12 noon in the Hospital Chapel to pray with and for staff and patients. (If you know somebody who will be in Hospital and would like a priest to visit, please let us know).

<u>7 MAY:</u> Coronation lunch after 10.15 Mass. Free admittance, but there will be a collection bucket for CAFOD to help the Turkey/Syria earthquake victims. Please be generous.

11 MAY: The next St Agnes Lunch will be at 12.30pm

<u>GOOD FRIDAY VENERATION OF THE CROSS AT OLR</u>: Please come forward and venerate with a simple bow of the head, or genuflection, or touch the Cross with your hand but, for hygiene purposes, please do not kiss the Cross. After the Service the Cross will remain in place for private veneration.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS: the Bishops of England and Wales have now given permission for parishes to be able to resume Holy Communion from the Chalice. The guidance is that each parish make a decision of what seems appropriate. Many parishes in our Diocese plan to wait until at least Corpus Christi (8th June) before resuming. Many parishes also are considering reintroducing the chalice only at (smaller) weekday Masses initially. We will follow the sensible suggestion of waiting a little longer, until Corpus Christi, and will update the parish in due course.

<u>CCTV AT OLR</u>: we are pleased to say that we now have CCTV installed in OLR, covering the porch and the main body of the church. With the church being open all day this will provide added security for the building and, most importantly, for the many people who pop in to say a prayer.

PRAYER AND MEDITATION FOR HOLY WEEK: Join Lawrence Freeman OSB, on the topic of Metanoia. *Metanoia is a Greek* word that simply means change your mind; something that comes right from the heart of the Gospel. <u>Silent Prayer</u>: "Stay here and keep watch with me; watch and pray". Keep company with Jesus in silent contemplation with this prayerful aid:

- Too often we fear the emptiness, the darkness, the silence within us. Yet it is there that the Spirit lives and works even when our prayer seems most arid. O God, help me to go daily into the quiet of my own heart, to meet you there in love and adoration.
- Hear the footsteps of God when silence reigns in your heart and mind.
- Thomas Merton's prayer: "Lord I do not know where I am going", makes a powerful meditation perfect for Holy Week.

POPE FRANCIS WRITES: "Living Holy Week, following Jesus, means learning to come out of ourselves in order to go to meet others, to go towards the outskirts of existence, to be the first to take a step towards our brothers and our sisters, especially those who are the most distant, those who are forgotten, those who are most in need of understanding, comfort and help. There is such a great need to bring the living presence of Jesus, merciful and full of love!"
