This coming week, 40 days after the Resurrection of the Lord we celebrate his Ascension into heaven. In his risen and glorified body our Lord Jesus Christ is now with the Father in heaven and the opening prayer for the Mass of the Ascension says, 'and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope.' The Ascension reminds us of our goal and of life's ultimate meaning. Here below though we each have our vocation to live which we do not do alone, but with the grace of the Holy Spirit. Here is a prayer given to Karol Wojtyla (the future Pope St John Paul II) when he was a boy from his father. He prayed it every day: 'Holy Spirit, I ask you for the gift of Wisdom to better know You and Your divine perfections, for Understanding to clearly discern the mysteries of the holy faith, for the gift of Counsel that I may live according to the principles of this faith, for Knowledge that I may always find it in you, for the gift of Fortitude that no fear or earthly preoccupations would ever separate me from you, for Piety that I may always serve Your Majesty with a filial love, and for the gift of the Fear of the Lord that I may dread sin, which offends You, O my God. Amen.' God bless you in this time leading up to Pentecost, Fr Bruno

LOURDES PILGRIMAGE OFFICE: 'Applications from pilgrims requiring assistance to journey with the Diocese Pilgrimage to Lourdes this summer are back to pre-Covid numbers – which is wonderful news, but it does mean we now need lots of helpers, nurses and HCA's to apply to make sure we have enough people to care for them in Lourdes. Further information is available on the Lourdes Pilgrimage (abdiocese.org.uk) website. The diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place 28 July to 3 August for those travelling by air, or 27 July to 4 August for those travelling by coach or jumbulance. The cost for Helpers and Clinicians is £680 (subsidised) or £850 full price. There are further subsidies which may be available'.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY AT OLR: The next Children's Liturgy at OLR will take place on Sundays 14 May and 28 May. This is a great opportunity for our younger children to be together to listen to the gospel in easy-to-understand language, and to have some fun doing a related activity. WORKING WITH GOD IN CREATION - Following on last Newsletter's piece Caring for our Planet we have decided to continue our focus on this vitally important issue. Many will know of Fr Pierre Teilhard de Chardin who linked his deep Jesuit spirituality to his scientific work and reflection. As a renowned palaeontologist, he explored humanity's early beginnings and our place in the ever-unfolding sweep of evolution. As a philosopher and theologian, he developed a unique synthesis of science and religion based on an evolutionary understanding of what he called the 'cosmic Christ' - the idea that the universe and everything in it is constantly moving towards to a point of perfection defined by unity and love, a point which he called 'the Omega point'. Now, the Omega Centre's mission is to deepen awareness of Teilhard de Chardin's integration of science and spirituality by providing insights and practices to enkindle awareness of love at the heart of reality.
