LENT BEGINS THIS WEEK with Ash Wednesday, a day of fasting and abstinence. These 40 days call us from the old to the new life Christ came to give us and which he won for us by his Cross and Resurrection. Jesus gives us three 'spiritual exercises' essential for real conversion in this season; prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. For prayer we have Scripture and the daily Lenten Mass readings, or the useful 'Walk with me' booklets to help us. In the parish we have daily Mass, times of Adoration, of Confession, and the Stations of the Cross during Lent. For Fasting we pray that our longing will make us yearn more for God, for his truth, his presence, and his grace. Fasting from social media and non-essential internet use could be something that frees us to give more time to God and to others. As for Almsgiving we can choose a good charity as well as giving some of our time to the lonely. Make humble and realistic resolutions and don't get discouraged if you slip up. Be at peace, trust in the loving mercy of the Lord and begin again. God bless you this Lent, Fr Bruno
