In these middle Sundays of Lent we have long readings from John's gospel of three astonishing encounters and miracles worked by Jesus. We had the Samaritan woman at the well (3rd Sun), the man born blind (4th), and the raising back to life of Lazarus (5th Sun). More than John telling us what happened once to these three people the gospel is telling us what Jesus has come to bring to all of fallen humanity. To the woman at the well who had not found the love she dearly longed for in this world Jesus reveals himself as the Lord and the quencher of her thirst for perfect love. In giving sight to the man born blind and revealing himself to the man as God Jesus reveals himself as the true light of the world come into the darkness of this world. In raising Lazarus back to life Jesus shows himself as the Lord of life itself, able to bring to life that which is dead. These priceless gifts, love, light, and life, Jesus came to give each one of us and he won them for us on the Cross. Thank you, Jesus! God bless you, Fr Bruno
