Two weeks ago we had the great joy of celebrating Easter, the greatest feast in the liturgical year. The first words at Mass on Easter Sunday are, 'I have risen, and I am with you still, Alleluia'. We could say that the core of our Catholic faith is contained in these words. 'I have risen' — our Lord Jesus Christ, who was crucified and died for us, is risen from the dead. He is risen and lives with a life that death has no power over. Then we hear the words, 'and I am with you still'. He returned despite what we did to him because he is love. And these words are spoken in the first person at the beginning of Mass because this is the privileged place of encounter with the Lord today. More than proclaiming Jesus to be risen the Church brings him to us in the Sacraments. Then we have the word, 'Alleluia' meaning 'Praise ye the Lord'. Yes, may God be ever praised. God bless each of you this Eastertide, Fr Bruno.

## SOME PROMPTS FOR PRAYER IN EASTERTIDE WITH POPE FRANCIS

APOSTLESHIP OF PRAYER: Each month Pope Francis entrusts a prayer intention to his Worldwide Prayer Network, the Apostleship of Prayer. These intentions express the Pope's concern for humanity and the mission of the Church. For this month of April 2024, the Holy Father requests us to pray "That the dignity and immense value of women be recognised in every culture and for an end to the discrimination that they experience in different parts of the world".

"We cannot lock the Spirit out of the house, or park him in some devotional zone; no, he has to be at the centre! Each day we need to say: Come, for without your strength we are lost".

"Let us revive the beauty of that moment when we realised that he is alive and we made him the Lord of our lives".

WORLD CHILDREN'S DAY: The first Catholic World Children's Day takes place 25–26 May 2024. Pope Francis announced this at the suggestion of a nine-year-old boy, Alessandro, who, just a few months ago had written to him with an idea to bring children together from different countries for a special event. Alessandro's hope was that the children could get to know one another, play and pray together, and become friends.

FILM NIGHT "RISEN" - Thurs 18 April at 7pm in OLR Parish Hall: Our next event will be the screening of the film "Risen", the epic biblical story of the Resurrection as told though the eyes of Clavius, a Roman soldier, tasked with solving what happened to Jesus after his crucifixion.
