OUR LADY OF LOURDES is venerated under this title by the Church due to her apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France. The first apparition of 11 February 1858, of which Bernadette Soubirous (age 14) told her mother that a "Lady" spoke to her in the cave of Massabielle, on the edge of the town, while she was gathering firewood with her sister and a friend. Similar apparitions of the "Lady" were reported on 18 occasions that year, until the climax revelation of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception took place. On 18 January 1862, the local Bishop of Tarbes endorsed the veneration of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Lourdes. On 1 February 1876, Pope Pius IX officially granted a decree of canonical coronation to the image as Notre-Dame du Saint Rosaire, performed by Cardinal Pier Francesco Meglia in the courtyard of what is now part of the Rosary Basilica on 3 July 1876. Saturday 11th will be her Feast and on Sunday 12th we will have a diocesan collection to support sending the sick and most needy to Lourdes this summer. Some parishioners, including myself, will also be blessed to participate in this Pilgrimage, carrying with us the prayers of all in the parish. We invoke her powerful intercession, especially for all parishioners and loved ones who are sick. Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us! God bless, Fr Kevin
