The Way of Discipleship

But we must always remember, alongside this teaching, Jesus' comforting words in Mt 11 "take up my yoke and learn from me ... my yoke is easy and my burden light". His yoke is the Cross, and we walk with the Lord shoulder to shoulder. He is our strength, our peace, and our joy. The Cross is not "radical suffering" but "radical loving" ... loving at all costs! As we begin this new "parish year" there is much good work to be done in the mission field of Eastbourne. I am delighted we have appointed Caroline Rother as our new Pastoral Assistant. Of the applicants Caroline came out with excellent experience, qualifications, and vision for the work to be done. She's also a very involved parishioner, known to many of you already.
