OUR PARISH

Following a series of important meetings of the Parish Pastoral Committees over recent months, representing our 3 churches, and ongoing reflection with Fr Bruno and others, I present some important actions below that we believe will help our parish to continue developing in a way that is MISSION focused, for the good of all.

<u>COMMUNITY:</u> To best serve the Parish community we need to know **WHO** we are. **From 1**st **May, over 4 weeks**, we will conduct a **PARISH CENSUS** to provide an up-to-date database. More details to follow. The key is for the census to be as complete as possible.

<u>CELEBRATION</u>: From Sunday 1st May we will realign our **SUNDAY MASSES** to allow 1 priest, in emergency (sickness etc), to cover all the parish Sunday Masses. <u>The new schedule will be:</u> **Sat 6 pm (OLR); Sun 9 am (St G's); 10.15 am (OLR); 11.30 am (St A's); 5.30 pm (OLR).** It will also allow us, in emergency, to help another parish where there is only 1 priest. These new times are only slight adjustments to pre-covid timings. Making our Church celebrations the best they can be is a top priority.

SERVICE: at the same time as the Census, we will conduct a **GIFTS / VOLUNTEERING AUDIT**, inviting everyone to consider how they might offer time and talent for the building up of the parish, but also allowing us to reach out and better serve the wider community.

From Easter Sunday (17th April) until Pentecost (5th June) we will be using a specially composed PARISH PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR RENEWAL, to help us to understand the key priorities we need to embrace as a parish in the time ahead. The Pastoral Committees, who I thank for all their hard work, have already put in lots of reflection which will be shared with you, and your own views and ideas will be gratefully sought. Further information will follow in the coming weeks. It's OUR PARISH, all of us together, and so I invite everyone to play their part, that the JOY OF THE GOSPEL may be more deeply experienced by us and shared with others.

God bless you for all you do and anticipating your generous response to the good and important challenges ahead!
