DIOCESAN FESTIVAL OF HOPE: 20 SEPTEMBER (ARDINGLY): Our Diocese will be gathering to celebrate its 60th Anniversary, the Jubilee Year of Hope, and the Pastoral Plan with its call to Mission. Sadly, space is limited which means that not everybody who might wish to attend will be able to. Each parish has a small number of tickets which will be allocated via its parish priest. Thanks for your understanding. The whole Diocese will be prayed for, and those attending will be encouraged to share back in their parishes the fruits of the day's reflections.

<u>TERMINALLY ILL ADULTS BILL</u>: The news that Parliament voted in favour of this Bill has been a shock and disappointment. Although a cause for great concern the fight is not over yet and the House of Lords will not cease to do all it can to oppose it.

<u>ABORTION</u>: This extreme *Abortion up to Birth* amendment was also passed with virtually no discussion or public consultation. But it is not law yet – and again the House of Lords will continue fighting. ### **OUR NEW PARISH - UPDATE**

I want to update you on where we are in the journey towards becoming a New Parish, joining together all the 8 parishes of our Eastbourne – St Leonard's Deanery. There have been, over the past 6 months, fruitful meetings of a Parish Leadership Group of the clergy and some lay reps from our parishes. There have also been plenty of meetings with the Diocese and those involved across the other Deaneries in this process. Our 11 Deaneries will become 11 large parishes in the coming months. We have realised as the months have passed that this is a "long haul" journey, not a sprint, that must not be rushed but instead, step by step and with everyone playing their part, we can build together a vibrant and mission centred "Community of Communities". We are now ready for more concrete work to be done and will begin in July working in 2 X Hub Leadership Groups, at the 2 ends of what will be the New Parish (Eastbourne and St Leonards). These Hub Leadership Groups, clergy and lay reps from each church, will work with you all in implementing changes that will allow us to use our many good resources in a way that best serves everybody, and also reaches out to those many people who are searching for Christ and faith. The first 2 important areas we are working on, ready for the autumn, will be [1] coordinating a joined-up approach to our Sacramental Programmes (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, RCIA etc), and [2] working on coordinated new Hub Mass Schedules that provide all our churches with a better thought-out and sustainable range of Mass times. In the coming days we will be launching a New Parish Website that will provide lots of detail of what's happening and how you can be involved [https://eastbournestleonards.org.uk]. Please continue to keep all this important work in your daily prayers. Many thanks. Fr Kevin (Moderator - on behalf of the Clergy Team)

SUNDAY MASS SHEETS: Some months ago, in a meeting with the Parish Pastoral Team (reps from each of our 3 churches), we unanimously agreed that it makes sense to now discontinue use of the weekly Sunday Mass Sheets. **The reasons are**: (1) most parishes would not have sheets as the Church encourages us to listen during the Mass, rather than be reading, and handling sheets becomes a distraction from this; (2) the cost and environmental waste of throwing away 1000 sheets at the end of each weekend. I appreciate that this change will impact on some parishioners who find it difficult to hear, or who are not confident in familiarity with the Mass prayers. Therefore, we will: (1) have some laminated Mass Cards with prayer texts in each church for those who need them; (2) there will be a small number of printed sheets with the Scripture readings for those who otherwise would struggle to hear the readings; (3) we will ensure that readers and microphones are all working well. There are excellent (free) phone apps and resources online that provide the texts for daily Mass. Details will be provided in the next newsletter. This new arrangement will begin from the end of July. Many thanks for your understanding -Fr Kevin
