# **GOD'S LOVE KNOWS NO BOUNDS**

Today's Scripture readings hold together the two strands of "leprosy" and "God's superabundant goodness". Leprosy, even if substantially now physically cured across the world, epitomises through the ages the state of being "unclean", and very particularly of being "religiously impure". This is a terrible state to be in, a terrible perception for others to have, and a painful label for anyone to have to carry! One thing that is clear beyond doubt in the Bible is that God has a special love and concern for people living with stigma and rejection. Jesus fulfils God's loving outreach to all who are marginalised or considered beyond redemption. Nobody is beyond redemption and, ironically, those who might be judged to be at risk of being so are shown by Jesus to almost always be far closer to the Kingdom and to God than the religiously upright. Isn't that the reversal at the very heart of the Gospel. Isn't that the key to not judging and instead humbly abandoning ourselves to God's love and mercy and helping others to do the same. As we pray today for prisoners, let us especially ask that they may live free from stigma and shame and be empowered to grow in all good ways under God's love. May we be to them and to all people ambassadors of mercy. God bless – Fr Kevin
